## I Recall...

## Young Guns

I recall around 50 years ago along with **Barry Govan** and **Ian Baxter**, from Melbourne, I was considered one of the '**Young Guns**' of playing card magic in Australia. **Barry** went on to become a world-class master of playing card sleight of hand. **Ian** also became an internationally known cardman. I didn't put in the practice necessary to reach the same standards, and somewhat fell behind.

Over the years I have met and watched others who became the new 'Young Guns,' some attaining a great level of ability, others becoming just a run-of-the-mill cardmen.

After moving to Adelaide in 1979 I became good friends with two other exceptionally good card/coin magicians, namely **Murray Cooper** and **Reg Launchbury**.

In my July 2020 column 'To Market, to Market' I wrote about having a trading stall at various markets, one of which was Fisherman's Wharf Market in Port Adelaide.

I recall writing the following.

"One day when both Garry Dunn and I were 'working' the stall a young lad came to our stall when we were practicing Dia Vernon's 'Twisting the Aces'. He asked 'Hey Boss' can you teach me that trick? We asked him; 'do you know how to do an 'Elmsley Count', he said no, and we both said then come back when you can. 2 weeks later he was back showing us the Elmsley Count, so we taught him 'Twisting the Aces'.

Who was this young lad? It was DeeJay Lloyd, who became a very good friend, he always calls me Boss".

He developed into a skilled cardman and still calls me Boss twenty years on.

I can recall about 2003, in Adelaide, I received a phone call from a young man who said he was given my phone No. from a mutual friend, he said he was a Professional Magician, I said something like "I am sorry, but I have never heard of you". I gave him my address and invited him to visit to show me what he could do.

When he came around, I could tell that he had great skill with a deck of cards, but no presentation or people skills. His name is **Shahin Zareei**, I took him under my wing and mentored him, smoothing out his technique, and worked on his presentation and people skills. In the process, he became a very good friend.

2007 saw me attending the ASM Centenary Convention in Melbourne along with a large contingent from Adelaide. Amongst the group was the young man that I had mentored and coached, **Shahin Zareei** an Iranian. I helped him with his routine, but he did not follow all my advice, for the close-up competition. His opening line was:

"Don't mess with me I'm a terrorist" (not scripted)

Shahin won the comp (along with Simon Coronel). In his acceptance speech, Shahin Said:

"I want to thank 3 people; My God, My Father, and Roy."

Without going into the details, instead of being judged by the Audience, the competition was judged by a panel of 5 selected persons. I am unable to recall the names of all five judges, but one was **Shawn Farquhar**, and another one was **Gerald Taylor** (Whom I hadn't seen for more than 25 years).

A little later that day a tall well-dressed gentleman came up to me and called me by name and congratulated me on my efforts with **Shahin**. The gentleman was **Gerald Taylor**, this was the last time I saw **Gerald**.

During my almost five (5) years in Vancouver, I have gotten to know the 'Young Guns' of today which include: Genpei Cai and James Nguyen. I must however give a special mention to a young man, Blake Aleong, who has skills way beyond his years and is also a member of Mensa.

We very recently had an online lecture by a young coin 'expert' **Jeffrey Wang**, whose skills, need to be seen to be believed, he is yet another of the up-and-coming 'Young Guns' of magic.

My time as a 'Young Gun' is well and truly over, but with all the 'Young Guns' coming through magic is in a very good place.

Recently members have promoted their services without paying a fee.


The VMC Executive Committee has agreed that a fee is to be reinstated and the fee be \$20.00 per year (January to December).

#### Roy's Deck Review

## **Torgmortrans Souvenir Playing Cards.**

#### 'Morflot'





The Soviet Kaliningrad company 'Torgmortrans' provides a wide range of ship chandler services in Kaliningrad, Svetly, Baltiysk and Pionersky ports. 'Torgmortrans' has been supplying ships in Kaliningrad since 1946. Included in the inventory were Souvenir Playing Cards that were printed at the Leningrad Colour Printing Plant Ленинградская цветная типография, Leningrad, Obukhovskoy Oborony Ave., 110 in the 1970s. under the brand name of 'Morflot.'

The **Ministry of the Maritime Fleet** (**Minmorflot**; transl. Министерство морского флота СССР) was a government ministry in the Soviet Union. The Merchant Maritime Fleet of the USSR is abbreviated '**Morflot**' (transl. Морфлот). All Soviet merchant fleet organizations and establishments were subordinate to the Ministry of the Maritime Fleet, abbreviated Minmorflot (transl. Минморфлот).

Until 25 May 1939, functions of the Minmorflot were carried out by the People's Commissariat of Water Transport, which was responsible for maritime and river fleets. The structure of the People's Commissariat of Maritime Fleet as a separate people's commissariat was confirmed by a decree of the Council of Ministers on 25 May 1939. On 15 March 1946, the People's Commissariat of the Maritime Fleet was renamed the Ministry of the Maritime Fleet by decree of the Supreme Soviet, along with all the other people's commissariats, which also became ministries. On March 15, 1953, Minmorflot was united with the Ministry of the River Fleet, becoming the Ministry of the Maritime and River Fleet.

By decree of the Presidium of the Supreme Council dated August 25, 1954, the Ministry of Maritime and River Fleet was reestablished on August 25, 1954, when the Ministry of Maritime Fleet and Ministry of River Fleet was redivided. Minmorflot was liquidated on December 26, 1991, due to the dissolution of the Soviet Union.





Even though this deck of cards is around 50 years old and in used condition, the cards themselves are bridge size and of a reasonable quality. They still spread well; however, Riffle and Faro shuffles are almost impossible.

The deck is a complete deck of 55 cards which includes 2 jokers and 1 blank-faced card. The faces are quite pretty.

This is a 'hard to find' deck with only two listed in collections on Portfolio 52, one of which is in my collection of 720 decks, I have not been able to put a \$ value on the deck, even though one sold on Buyworthy (No longer in business), I wasn't prepared to pay to be a part of the site, so I have no idea what it sold for. Other similar decks are being sold on eBay for between \$20 and \$60.

If you find one for your collection, buy it.

#### SHADOW WALLET

Dee Christopher & the 1914



The Shadow wallet claims that it is the world's slimmest self contained index and peek wallet that will supposedly fit into any pocket including the skinniest of jeans, or purse, bag, etc. It comes in three styles: (and if you purchase yours from Vanishing inc, you will, like so many of their other products, get one that is "gorgeous"; not sure how or why they always seem to label cards, books, gimmicks, etc as gorgeous, but go figure).



There is a limited edition Bourbon brown leather, classic black leather and the carbon fiber (black). Once again, all "gorgeous" like so many of their other products, however, if NOT purchased at Vanishing inc, I really can't be sure that it will still be of the "gorgeous" variety.

So, what can you do with it? First off, let me say that it is quite small, able to hold some credit cards and perhaps a little cash stuffed in there. Quite frankly, calling it a wallet is a bit of a stretch. The Shadow wallet claims, that with it's aid, you will be able to:

- Do a unique book test with a single page folded up inside your wallet.
- Peek info written on a business card.
- Pull a named card from the wallet, then show it's empty. (everything is included to be able to do this).


You also get a 2 hour "Masterclass" download on/about using your "gorgeous" new wallet.

All for just \$65.00 U.S. which as you know, these days is like what? \$200 Canadian? But I digress, please forgive the sarcasm, however, I truly believe that you are much better off purchasing a good magic book, or a real/full sized wallet if that's what you want. Then again, maybe just leave it in your bank account.

It is well made and real leather, however, some of the handlings are a bit awkward and fussy for my liking, then again, maybe I'll give it another chance one day.


